

## MOUSE POINTER SETTINGS

Spare your eyes with these mouse pointer settings

Playing “find the mouse pointer” is no fun for anyone with less than 20/20 vision, especially on the latest super-high-resolution laptops. Luckily, there are solutions built into every modern version of Windows. You’ll find the necessary settings in the classic Control Panel, under Mouse Options:

1. Open the **Control Panel** and click on the **Mouse** option. The **Mouse Properties** window opens.
2. Click on the **Pointers** tab at the top of the window.
3. Then, click on the down-arrow under **Schemes**.
4. Select either **Large** or **Extra Large** schemes to make the pointer bigger. Then click on the **Save As** tab, then click **OK**.
5. Now click on the **Pointer Options** tab. Select the **Display Pointer Trails** check box to make the pointer easier to see as it moves. (If you find the pointer trails distracting just unselect the pointer trails check box)
6. At the bottom on that same tab, select the **Show Location Of Pointer When I Press The CTRL Key** option. Then click **OK** to save your changes and close the dialog box.
